EV Basics EVs, sometimes referred to in-game as “base points,” stands for Effort Values. Each Pokémon has a total of 508 EVs to distribute freely in its stats. There is not only a cap on how many EVs each Pokémon can have total, but also a cap on the maximum allowed EV investment in each stat: 252 EVs per stat.

EV TRAINING TIPS UNIT 3. Start young. You can often max out the EVs by level 20, which leaves the Pokemon free for use in-game; it will also be stronger than normal. Spread EVs out a little. Many guides you will see will tell you to max out your EVs in two stats (e.g. Attack and Speed) and forget about the rest.

Newly-hatched eggs and Pokémon caught in the wild - regardless of level - have no EVs and thus act as a blank sheet for EV training. Any Pokémon that has gained experience points from battling will have gained some EVs. Every 4 EVs obtained in a particular stat equals one more point for that stat, by the time that Pokémon reaches level 100.

The best time to start EV training is as soon as you get that Pokémon, either through breeding or catching it. As soon as that Pokémon participates in a battle in which it gains experience, it will have gained some EVs. If you were to breed a Pokémon you probably won't be able to battle with it right away, due to it only being Level 1.

IV and EV Training Guide. Individual Values (IVs) IVs have the most influence of any stat on any Pokémon. Like Natures, it is what makes every Pokemon unique, because once caught, a Pokemon's IVs do not change. Pokémon caught in the wild will have IVs for each of the six base stats, they will be a random number between 0-31.

IV and EV Training Guide - Pokémon VR Map

Once a Pokémon is called, simply KO the Pokémon that was called and repeat the process until you're finished EV training. If you are trying to max out a stat, you need 7 KOs to get 252 EVs (36*7), assuming you're beating Pokémon that give out 1 EV. Note: Several of these Pokémon are found in ambushes.
