Polysomnography records your brain waves, the oxygen level in your blood, heart rate and breathing, as well as eye and leg movements during the study. Polysomnography is usually done at a sleep disorders unit within a hospital or at a sleep center.

Scoring an arousal in a sleep study. According to the American Academy of Sleep Medicine (AASM), the patient must be asleep for at least 10 continuous seconds before an arousal can be scored. Also, a minimum of 10 continuous seconds of intervening sleep is needed to score a second arousal.
