The nursing diagnosis Noncompliance is defined as behavior of person and/or caregiver that fails to coincide with a health-promoting or therapeutic plan agreed on by the person (and/or family and/or community) and health care professional. In the presence of an agreed-on health-promoting or therapeutic plan, a person's or caregiver's behavior is fully or partially nonadherent and may lead to clinically ineffective outcomes.

Therefore, treatment plans are usually multidisciplinary, may involve parent-mediated interventions, and target the child's individual needs. Behavioral intervention strategies have focused on social communication skill development—particularly at young ages when the child would naturally be gaining these skills—and reduction of restricted interests and repetitive and challenging behaviors.

Emphasize the importance of adhering treatment plan. Failure to comply is one of the most common reasons why treatment plans for hypertension fail.
