The gender pay gap has narrowed to a record low but is closing slowly. According to the Office for National Statistics (ONS) the average female worker earned 17.9% less than her male counterpart, down from 18.4% last year. Since 2011 the gender pay gap has fallen by an average of just 0.3 percentage points a year.

However, in every occupation group the gender pay gap is in favour of men. In addition, where the pay gap is the highest, men have the highest full time employment share (92 percent in skilled trade occupations). Where the gap is the smallest (sales and customer service occupations) the gender split is close to 50:50.
