Childhood Exposure to Domestic Violence Scale (CEDV) The CEDV is a 42-item, self-administered questionnaire designed for children ages 10 to 16 years old. It takes approximately 30 minutes for youth to complete the questionnaire.

### Measuring Violence-Related Attitudes, Behaviors, and ...

The study by Shahinfar et al. (2000) provides an example of the discrepancy between child self-report and parent report on the Violence Exposure Scale for Children (VEX), one of the selected measures. The authors administered the VEX to preschool children and their parents to assess for exposure to community violence and found no statistically significant relationship between child and parent reports.

### Review of Tools for Measuring Exposure to Adversity in ...

Exposure to Violence Scales: Grades 6–12 (EVS) Witnessing of, and victimization from, five specific violent acts prior to age 10 were assessed: threats, slapping/hitting/punching, beatings, knife attacks, and shootings (Singer, Anglin, Song, & Lunghofer, 1995). Items regarding sexual abuse were not administered.

### Violence Breeds Violence: Childhood Exposure and ...

Students were eligible to participate in the program if they (1) had substantial exposure to violence, defined as being the victim or witness of violence involving a knife or gun or having a Life Events Scale summed score greater than 6, consistent with exposure to 3 or more violent events; (2) had symptoms of PTSD in the clinical range ...

### A Mental Health Intervention for Schoolchildren Exposed to ...

A lesser known scale that addresses children's exposure to domestic violence is the Victimization Scale (Nadel et al., 1996) as found in the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's compendium of assessment tools Measuring Violence-Related Attitudes, Beliefs, and Behaviors Among Youths (Dahlberg, Toal, & Behrens, 1998).

### Assessing child exposure to adult domestic violence ...

exposure to violence. This instrument was developed based on an exposure to violence scale for children by Richters and Martinez (1990).1Their study used written descriptions of violence and was used with elementary school aged children.

### Violence Exposure Scale Revised (VEX-R)

The Violence Exposure Scale for Children-Revised (VEX-R) and the Substance Exposure Assessment (SXA) were given to 104 children participating in a longitudinal study of in-utero cocaine exposure (IUCE) at age 8.5, 9.5, and 11 years.

### Preadolescents' report of exposure to violence

This is the VEX-Rä , the Violence Exposure Scale for Children - Revised (Full Scale Version) which was revised in 1995. However, validity and reliability data are not yet available. A modified version of the My ETV instrument is being developed and piloted among children ages 6-8 years (FJ Earls, personal communication) however reliability and validity data are not yet available.

### MacArthur SES & Health Network | Research

Developed by Richters and Saltzman (1990), the 54-item Survey of Exposure to Community Violence (SECV) measures how often people are exposed to different threats in their communities (e.g., being chased, drug activity, being arrested, physical assault, or witnessing a suicide or homicide). ### Survey of Exposure to Community Violence (SECV): Self ...

To address the lack of measures specific to children's experience of parental IPV, Edleson et al. (2008) developed the Child Exposure to Domestic Violence (CEDV) Scale. The CEDV is a child self-report measure consisting of forty-two items that are divided into three sections with six subscales.

The KID-SAVE (Flowers et al., 2000) is a measure of violence exposure for children in grades 3 through 7. The scale consists of 34 items loading onto three subscales: Traumatic Violence, Indirect Violence, and Physical/Verbal Abuse.
