Vocabulary Frames Turn the traditional vocabulary review index card into a higher order thinking strategy for learning new words. In this activity, students will create vocabulary frames using concept terms. They will develop a definition based on their own understanding (right corner), as well as the opposite (left corner).

## Vocabulary Strategies - Learning Tasks

Vocabulary instruction should (1) provide students with information that contains the context as well as the meaning of the word, (2) design instruction that engages students and allows sufficient time for word learning, (3) make sure students have multiple exposures to the words with review and practice, and (4) create a dialogue around the words.
