Explicit instruction in transcription skills (i.e. spelling and handwriting) and teaching writing strategies was found to improve overall writing ability by a greater degree than if instruction focused on improving content quality or mechanical aspects alone (see Edwards, 2003 for a review).

Writing strategies (teaching students explicit strategies for planning, revising, and editing) Summarization (teaching students explicit strategies for summarizing written material) Collaborative writing (arranging students in groups to plan, draft, revise, and edit their writing)
